CBSE CLASS X RESULTS 2024 – 100% PASS RATE

Our School has once again set a benchmark of academic excellence with a stellar 100% pass rate in the CBSE Class X Board Examinations 2024. Our topper, Hasna Fathima K T, secured an impressive 92.8%, followed by Ridha Fathima E K (91.2%), Muhammed Arfan P (91%), and Liba Anvar (90.6%).
