2025-26: Year of Achievements

I. Academic Excellence

Our Grade 10 students delivered an outstanding performance.

The school toppers, Fathima Bathool and Abu Asal A V., secured an impressive 93.6% in the CBSE Board Examination 2025.

A total of four students achieved a perfect 100% score in Arabic and emerged as National toppers, bringing exceptional pride to our school. A total of 16 students secured Distinction, and six students achieved First Class.

For the past 12 years, Mount Hira English School has consistently produced outstanding results, maintaining a 100% pass percentage with exemplary performance in the CBSE Class X Board Examination.

1. LEAP TALENT SEARCH EXAMINATION

The LEAP Talent Search Examination fosters students' confidence while sharpening their competitive spirit and critical thinking skills. **Conducted on 16 September 2025**, the examination witnessed the enthusiastic participation of 830 students. The school proudly produced State-level toppers Amrozia and Athif Aslam of Grade 5, reflecting outstanding competitive excellence. The results were equally commendable, with 56 A grades, 79 B grades, and 94 C grades, underscoring the academic depth and competitive preparedness of our students.

2. HIKMA TALENT SEARCH EXAMINATION

In the contemporary world, nurturing students with strong faith, sound knowledge, and noble values is more important than ever. The HIKMA Talent Search Examination provides a great opportunity to enrich the Islamic consciousness of every learner.

The HIKMA Talent Search Examination held on 8 November 2025 witnessed an overwhelming participation of 816 students. Adding to this remarkable achievement, three state-level toppers—Aiba Fathima P. (2A), Amrozia (5A), and Athif Aslam (5A)—brought exceptional honour and pride to the school. The outstanding results were further crowned by the achievements of 66 A+ grade holders and 93 A grade holders, standing as a powerful testimony to the dedication of our students and the academic excellence fostered at Mount Hira.
